PLAN

AT LAST - SUCCESS ! Having initiated the idea of a new plan in the early 70's, Frank and Mike have ensured the protection of the Residential Area from commercial encroachment for many years. It sets out to reduce through traffic by closing Crombey Street, the improvement of the environment generally and includes Resident's Parking. It is also hoped residents will be generally encouraged to improve their homes and take advantage of the Government 95% grant.



MORSE STREET

COUNCILLOR FRANK RICHARDS -

A MEMBER OF PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE has discussed with Officers and raised with the Committee, the problems of heavy vehicles leaving Brunel. Methods of reducing this nuisance are being considered.

GARRARD SITE : Part of the C.A.P. and as a result of Councillors Richards and Bawden's pressure, sets out an office block at the roundabout end and central open space with residential use at Newcastle Street end.

An approach to the site owners that elderly persons accommodation could be provided, has been received sympathetically.

Car parking at Newcastle Street end is not considered acceptable by Frank and Mike.
