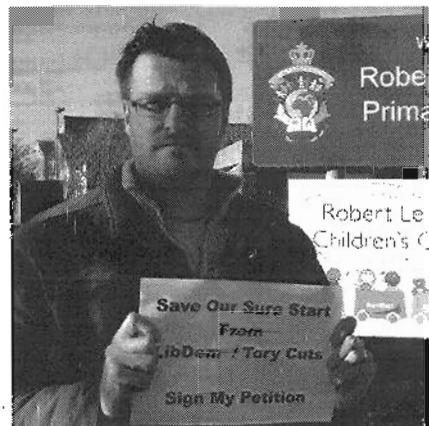


Dunsford Close Canvassing

Suspected Drug Dealing

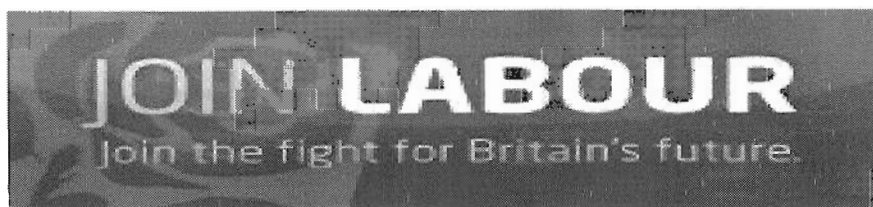

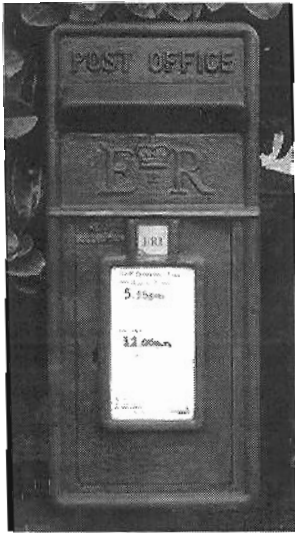
Fly Tipping in Dunsford Close

Where is the Clifton Street Post Box?

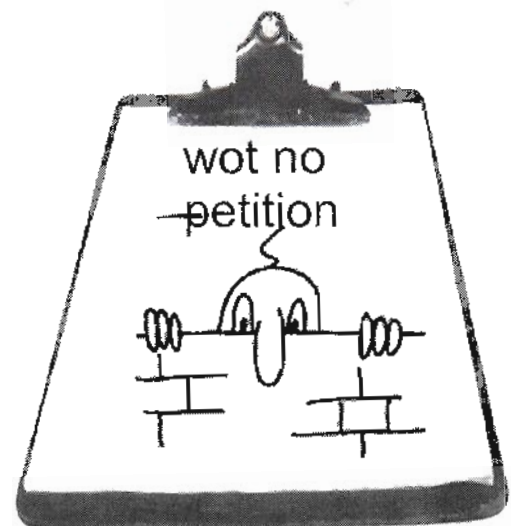
